Camp will run primarily outdoors on our 5 acres of school grounds. Junior campers (ages 4-6) will enjoy a play-based curriculum interwoven with crafts and outdoor activities. Senior campers (ages 7-11) will celebrate the joys of summer through a variety of stimulating crafts and activities, exploration in nature, music, and co-operative games. The leaders of the camp are experienced Waldorf teachers and early childhood educators who provide structure and leadership for a unique and memorable camp experience.

Please find enclosed dates and costs for the camp as well as a registration form and medical form. The registration form and medical form must be completed, and **full payment made** to reserve a spot at camp. The early bird discount of \$25 weekly applies to registrations and fees that are received and processed prior to April 1<sup>st</sup>.
