



## **French Teacher Part-Time**

Halton Waldorf School is seeking a part-time (60%) French teacher starting August 2023.

This part-time position includes the following job duties and responsibilities: preparing and delivering French lessons to students in grades 1-5; teaching creatively using a phenomenological approach; preparing and providing necessary materials; classroom management; student assessment, report writing; meeting with parents/guardians regarding their child's progress upon request and for parent/teacher conferences; liaising with faculty and administration; participating in professional development and pedagogical faculty meetings (Thursday evenings 4pm-6pm) .

- Minimum university bachelor's degree, Bachelor of Education, or equivalent combination of education and work experience
- Interest in learning about Waldorf pedagogy
- A living connection to French language and culture
- Native French speaker or oral fluency
- Skilled in classroom management and discipline follow-through
- Strong organizational skills and the ability to multi-task
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, approachable for student, parents, and colleagues
- Willingness and proven ability to work within a community environment
- A creative and artistic approach to teaching
