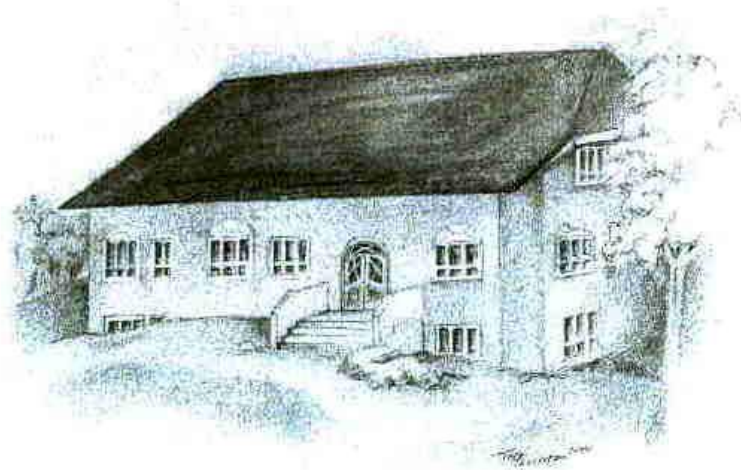

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, along with an approachable manner
- Willingness and ability to work cooperatively with others
